UPDATE:

On Friday, December 28, 2018, at 2250 hours, Officers responded to a shooting of two male adults in the 300 block of East Ramsey Street in the City of Banning. One of the victims succumbed to his injuries at a local hospital. The victim was identified Alex Marcotte, an eighteen-year-old resident of the City of Banning. The second victim is in stable condition at a local hospital and will not be identified. Detectives are currently seeking the public's help in locating a suspect in the death of Marcotte. Detectives have positively identified Brody Baca, a twenty-year-old resident of the City Banning, as a suspect in the case. If Baca is seen, the Banning Police Department asks that you contact authorities immediately and do not approach Baca. Baca is considered armed and dangerous.

Baca has relatives in San Bernardino, Hemet, Arizona, and Banning. If anyone has any additional information about Baca or his whereabouts, you are encouraged to contact the Banning Police Department at 951-922-3170.

ORIGINAL PRESS RELEASE:

On Friday, December 28, 2018, at about 2250 hours, officers from the Banning Police Department were dispatched to a 9-1-1 hung-up call in the 300 block of East Ramsey Street in the City of Banning. Once officer arrived in the area, they located two adult males who appeared to be suffering from apparent gunshot wounds. The victims will not be identified at this time. Both victims were transported by paramedics to a local hospital. One of the victims succumbed to his injuries while at the hospital. The second victim was admitted and is considered to be in critical condition.

Banning Police Department Detectives were summoned to the scene and assumed the investigation. At this time, there is no additional information to release as the investigation continues. When additional information is available, the Banning Police Department will provide the updated information.
