**Subject:** Commercial Vehicle Parking Permits

Beginning February 11, 2008, the Banning Police Department will begin enforcing Banning Municipal Ordinance No. 1327 pertaining to commercial vehicle parking within the city limits. Overnight commercial vehicle parking in the City will be restricted to Banning residents' only who must purchase a commercial vehicle parking permit for their vehicle. Vehicles owned and/or operated by Banning residents' must display a valid parking permit and park on East Bryant Street between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M. Annual parking permit applications can be obtained from the Banning Police Department along with an informational pamphlet on the regulations involving the operation of commercial vehicles in the City. The cost of a commercial parking permit is \$100, which must be renewed on an annual basis. Until February 11, 2008, the Banning Police Department will be educating the public on this new ordinance and issuing warnings to vehicles found in violation.
