To more effectively handle an increasing demand for police reports and provide the community with a convenient and timely process for completing police reports, the Coplogic Online Reporting System has been established at the Banning Police Department. The online system provides the community the ability to complete specific non-emergency police reports involving no suspects or crime scene evidence instead of calling or coming to the Police Department.

The Coplogic System is designed for non-emergency incidents within the City limits, which are not in progress, involve no injuries, suspects, or crime scene evidence, and which do not require a police presence.

The following crimes and reports may be filed using the Coplogic System: Child Custody Violations, Check Fraud, Theft of Recyclables, Lost Property, Illegal Dumping, Vehicle Burglary, Non-Injury Traffic Collisions, Credit Card Fraud, Theft, Abandoned Vehicle, Animal Complaints, Vehicle Tampering, Harassing Phone Calls, Identity Theft, Mail Theft, Vandalism, Graffiti, and Vehicle Hit and Runs.

Additionally, the Banning Police Department is implementing a new crime fighting tool known as TipSoft, which allows citizens to submit anonymous crime fighting tips online. Citizens now have the ability to pass on specific information concerning criminal activity, including photos, while remaining anonymous.

The Banning Police Department encourages everyone to report information about any non-urgent illegal activity, such as unsolved cases, vandalism, theft, the sale and distribution of drugs or information about crimes that are being planned in the community or schools.
