**Incident:** Strong-arm Robbery

**Incident:**

On January 29, 2008, about 1445 hours, Banning Police Officers responded to the Bank of America parking lot, located at 1374 W. Ramsey Street in regards to a strong-arm robbery. The victim interrupted the suspects, Nicole Robinson, a resident of Banning and an unknown White or Hispanic male as they attempted to siphon gasoline from her vehicle. The victim was then assaulted and had her purse taken from her possession. Both suspects fled the scene on-foot, running through neighborhoods. Robinson was apprehended by Banning Police Officers and Riverside County Sheriff's Deputies.

The male suspect was not apprehended and still remains outstanding. Robinson was booked into the Smith Correctional Facility in Banning. Upon further investigation, it was later determined that the victim had her digital video disc player and backpack stolen from her vehicle. The stolen items were never recovered.
