**Incident:** Residential Burglary/Stolen Vehicle Arrest

On Friday, February 08, 2013, about 12: 00 pm, Banning Police Officers responded to a report of a vehicle that had just been stolen in the area of Old Idyllwild Road x San Gorgonio Avenue, Banning. As officers were arriving on scene, they located the vehicle, a black 2013 Ford Mustang that had slid off the road. Officers soon discovered the suspect lying injured in a field near the vehicle. The suspect, 18 year old Anzell Coleman, was taken into custody without incident.

Further investigation revealed that Coleman, who resides in Banning, had just burglarized a residence located nearby. He had placed numerous stolen items into the Mustang which he had also stolen from the same residence. As he was attempting to flee the area, he lost control of the vehicle and drove through a fence, causing the vehicle to roll over which resulted in Coleman sustaining moderate injuries. All stolen items were recovered and returned to the victim.

Coleman was transported to Riverside County Regional Medical Center for treatment of his injuries prior to being booked into jail on multiply felony charges.
