Incident: Felony Evading and Drunk Driving, Case #08-580

On 02-14-08, at approximately 1544 hours, Officers from the Banning Police Department attempted to stop a motorcyclist on a sport bike for failing to stop at a posted stop sign and other traffic violations. The motorcyclist was also speeding, weaving on the roadway, and driving on the wrong side of the roadway. The Officers believed that the motorcyclist was possibly a Drunk driver.

A vehicle pursuit was initiated. The pursuit transversed over city streets for approximately 2 miles. The motorcyclist lost control of his motorcycle and he was involved in a single vehicle traffic collision at North Hathaway Street and Morongo Road. The motorcyclist laid the motorcycle on its' right side as he tried to brake hard for a left turn. The motorcycle sustained major damage as it collided with the pavement.

The suspect, later identified as James Leon Daily of Banning, 35-years-old, was taken into custody without any further incident. No other motorists or vehicles were involved in the traffic collision.

The suspect suffered minor injuries. The suspect was later booked into the Larry D. Smith Correctional Facility for violation of Felony Evading, Drunk Driving, and Parole violations.
