**Incident:** Suspicious Circumstances Call, Case #08-803

On 02-28-08, at approximately 1345 hours, the Banning Police Department was notified by the Palm Springs Police Department regarding an anonymous report that was filed on their on-line reporting system. The Palm Springs Police Department advised they had just reviewed an on-line report which was made by an unknown/anonymous subject on 02-26-08.

The anonymous subject advised he had been inside a major retail store in Palm Springs and he overheard a conversation between two unknown White males. The unknown males talked about placing a bomb in the Ace Colors/Remax building in Banning. The anonymous reporting party did not provide any other details.

On 02-28-08, at approximately 1446 hours, Officers from the Banning Police Department, an officer from the California Highway patrol with his K-9 (bomb dog), and personnel from CalFire responded to Ace Colors/Remax at 515 West Ramsey Street in Banning. The premises and area were thoroughly searched with assistance from the K-9 (bomb dog). No suspicious devices or objects were located.
