Subject: Homicide Investigation

On 12/31/2007, at approximately 2220 hours, members of the Banning Police Department responded to a 911 call from a residence located in the 500 block of West Hoffer Street in reference to a gunshot victim. The victim was identified as Mark Allen Owsley of Banning. Owsley was transported to San Gorgonio Memorial Hospital in Banning, where he later succumbed to the gunshot wound. At that point, a homicide investigation was initiated and after several months of development, an arrest warrant was approved by the Riverside County District Attorneys Office and issued by Riverside County Superior Court naming Steve Ray Strebe, also of Banning, as the suspect in this case for violating California Penal Code 187/Homicide. As of this date, Banning Police Department Detectives have been unable to locate Strebe. Strebe has relatives in the Banning area and in central and northern California. Banning Police Department's Investigations Division is seeking assistance from the public in apprehending Strebe.
