On 04/13/10, about 0626 hours, the Banning Police Department received a report from a witness of a possible theft occurring in the 1800 block area of north Hathaway Street in the City of Banning (Match Corporation). The witness provided dispatch with suspect and suspect vehicle descriptions.

As officers responded to the area, they observed the suspect vehicle travel westbound onto the I-10 Freeway from Hargrave Street. Officers conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle in the area of westbound I-10 freeway at the 8<sup>th</sup> Street off-ramp. The suspects were detained for further investigation regarding the possible theft. During the course of the investigation, officers learned the suspects were involved in the theft, which had just occurred, and were in possession of stolen property.

The suspects were identified as:

- Brett McCracken, 55 years, from Running Springs, California
- Dolly Ingram, 53 years, from Running Springs, California

The victim of the theft valued the stolen / recovered property, which included an electric pump and copper wiring at \$1450. The victim also estimated damaged caused by the suspect(s) during the theft at \$200.

Both McCracken and Ingram were booked into the Larry D. Smith Correctional Facility in Banning for various charges including: possession of stolen property, theft, conspiracy to commit theft, possession of burglary tools, possession of marijuana and possession of methamphetamine.
