Incident: Shooting at inhabited dwelling

On 04-16-13, about 7:15 pm, officers responded to a report of shots being fired at a residence in the 1900 block of West Williams Street, Banning.

When officers arrived, they were told that several gang members opened fire on a residence located at 1790 W. Williams Street. The suspects left the area in a black Chrysler prior to officers arriving on scene. A Riverside County Sheriff's Deputy observed a vehicle matching the description given by witnesses traveling eastbound on the I-10 Freeway onramp at Ramsey Street. The deputy observed a subject throw an unknown object from the vehicle along the Ramsey Street I-10 underpass. The deputy lost sight of the vehicle, but was able to recover a hand gun along the side of the onramp to the freeway.

No one was injured during the shooting and the investigation is ongoing.
