Incident: Burglary and Crimes against Elders

On April 23, 2009, Detectives from the Banning Police arrested Christina Ines Gale in the 16000 block of Seattle Slew Drive, in the City of Moreno Valley for a series of burglaries she committed while employed at The Lakes Independent & Assisted Living in the 5800 Block area of Sun Lakes Blvd.

Gale burglarized six residential rooms at The Lakes Retirement Community taking an undisclosed amount of money and jewelry. Gale's method of operation included assisting the elderly residents and weekly cleaning services.

Detectives recovered stolen items from a local pawn shop and Gale's residence in the City of Moreno Valley, CA. The property recovered during a search included: a gold bracelet and gold earrings with red stones.

Gale was charged with six counts of 459 PC, Burglary, 503 PC, Embezzlement and 368 (e) PC, Crimes Against Elder of Dependent Adults. Gale was later booked into the Riverside County Sheriff's Smith Correctional Facility in Banning
