Incident: Major Injury Traffic Collision

On 4-30-09, at approximately 6:42 P.M., Banning Police Officers responded to the area of Phillips Street and Hoffer Street in regards to a report of traffic collision involving a single motorized scooter. When officers arrived, they found that the driver, 38 year old Jose Zayas of Banning, had sustained a major head injury. Cal Fire responded to provide aid and determined that Zayas had life threatening injuries and needed to be flown to a nearby trauma center. Mercy Air arrived and transported Zayas to Desert Regional Medical Center. A witness reported that Zayas was traveling at a high rate of speed and not wearing a helmet at the time of the collision. The cause of the collision is still under investigation.
