### **Incident:**

On May 8, 2008, Banning Police Officers responded to 726 W. Nicolet Street #7, in regards to an assault with a deadly weapon. Upon arrival to the residence, Officers contacted the victim, Patrick Thompson who had suffered a stab wound to the abdomen. Thompson informed officers that he had been stabbed by his wife, Tiffany R. Skinner, during a domestic altercation at their residence. Patrick was transported by ambulance to the Riverside County Regional Hospital, in the City of Moreno Valley. Upon arrival to the hospital, doctors' immediately performed exploratory surgery for his injuries. Patrick is now listed in stable condition.

Tiffany left the residence prior to officers arriving on scene. It was determined through investigation that Tiffany had acquired a ride from a friend and fled to the City of Beaumont. Officers from the Banning Police Department discovered the location she had fled to and apprehended her with assistance from the Beaumont Police Department. Tiffany was located at an address in the Noble Creek Apartments, in the City of Beaumont.
