On May 8, 2009 Banning Police Detectives arrested James Daniel Fidler III for his involvement in a residential burglary that occurred on December 22, 2008, in the 1000 Block area of 12th Street, in the City of Banning.

On December 23, 2008, Fidler pawned numerous pieces of stolen jewelry from the burglary at a local pawn shop. Detectives recovered the stolen property which was valued at approximately \$4,000 dollars. The property was returned to the owner. A juvenile male was also arrested and booked earlier into the Riverside County Juvenile Hall for his participation in the burglary and a series of other burglaries that occurred in the Cities of Banning and Beaumont.

Fidler was charged with 496 (a) PC, possession of stolen property, 459 PC, burglary and 666 PC, petty thefts with priors. He was transported and booked into the Riverside County Sheriff's, Larry Smith Correctional Facility in Banning.
