Incident: Report of a Student with a Gun

On 05/20/10, about 10:14 a.m., the Banning Police Department School Resource Officer received information that a male juvenile student was in possession of a gun at Banning High School.

Following the Riverside County “Kids with Guns” Protocol, the School Resource Officer summoned additional officers and with assistance of school staff, they contacted the student. Upon contact, the student refused to cooperate with the officers’ directions and resisted the officers’ efforts to search him for weapons. The male juvenile was eventually arrested and searched. No weapons were found on his person or in his belongings, but the juvenile was arrested for resisting, delaying and obstructing a peace officer.

The male juvenile received minor injuries during the struggle. After being medically cleared at the San Geronio Memorial Hospital, the sixteen year old male juvenile was booked into the Riverside County Juvenile Hall in Riverside.
