Incident: Shots Fired at Moving Vehicle

On May 21, 2010, about 1805 hours, Banning Police dispatch received numerous calls regarding gunshots being fired in the area of 12th Street and West Williams Street. One witness reported several Hispanic males and females shooting at a church. Officers responded to the area and found a black SUV crashed into a wall on private property at the northwest corner of 12th Street and West Williams Street. Officers discovered the SUV had been struck by several bullets. Additional witnesses were contacted and reported that a Hispanic male in his 20's walked from an alley on 12th Street while the SUV drove past. The Hispanic male opened fire on the SUV. The SUV subsequently crashed and four occupants fled the area in different directions. At this time, none of the occupants have been located and the suspect shooter is still outstanding. Additionally, it was discovered the church was not damaged or shot at during this incident. The investigation is ongoing.
