**Incident:** Shots Fired (Case 10-1963)

On Thursday, May 27<sup>th</sup>, 2010, about 1:59 p.m., Banning Police officers responded to a shots fired call in the 1900 block area of West Williams Street, Banning. Upon arrival, officers learned that two vehicles, a green compact car and a white Ford Mustang, fled the area at a high rate of speed prior to police arrival.

Officer's located two bullet casings, as well as broken glass on the roadway. The white Ford Mustang was later located parked in the 300 block of Geneva Street. The vehicle had collision damage as well as two flat tires.

Through investigative leads, it was determined that a verbal confrontation occurred in the 2100 block area of West Williams Street, between the occupants of the unknown green compact vehicle and the occupants of the white Ford Mustang. The verbal confrontation led to a pursuit of the green vehicle by the occupants of the White Ford Mustang, culminating with shots fired in the 1900 block area of West Williams Street. The occupants of the green compact vehicle, as well as the occupants of the white Ford Mustang, then fled the area.

There were no signs that anyone was injured. This is an ongoing investigation.
