Incident: Unruly Party/Unlawful Assembly

On 06-06-10, about 12:30 a.m., Banning Police Officers responded to the 1300 block of East Williams Street regarding a noise complaint. When Officers arrived, they found approximately 50-70 persons in the street, sidewalks and in the parking spaces to the apartments located at 1330, 1350 and 1370 East Williams Street. Officers were able to disperse the crowd without any force although they met some resistance.

Later that morning, about 0130 hours, Banning Police Officers were again dispatched to 1370 East Williams Street regarding several Black males fighting in the street. Because of the earlier resistance met by the Officers, assistance was requested from the San Geronio Special Operations Gang Task Force, Riverside County Sheriff's Office, Riverside County Sheriff's air support helicopter and Beaumont Police Department. When Officers arrived, they found the fight had ended, but a large group of people were still gathered. The assembly was declared to be unlawful and a dispersal order was given to the crowd to leave. Officers arrested six adults and one juvenile who failed to disperse. The six adults were booked into the Larry D. Smith Correctional Facility for failing to follow a dispersal order and the juvenile was released to his parent.
