Location: 4000 Block of West Hoffer Street

Incident: Hit and Run with injury/child endangerment arrest

On July 1st, 2008 at 2:17 A.M., Banning Police Department Officers responded to the 800 block of Omar Street, for a report of a vehicle that collided into a house. According to the reporting party, a red vehicle struck the front of her house and fled the scene.

Through investigation, it was later determined that the vehicle, a red Mercury Sable, had collided into a parked vehicle at the 600 block of West Wilson Street prior to colliding with the house on Omar Street. After striking the parked vehicle, the driver made a U-turn on Wilson Street and continued westbound on Wilson Street. The driver attempted a right turn onto Omar Street and collided into the house.

Upon impact into the house, a female sleeping inside the residence suffered injuries and required medical care. The suspect vehicle fled the scene and responding officers followed a trail of fluid and debris on the roadway which led to a residence located in the 4000 block of West Hoffer Street.

A search warrant was served at the residence and a red vehicle was found parked and covered inside the garage. The vehicle, later taken as evidence, had damage consistent with the two collisions. The residents, later identified as, Sarah Isabelle Baldwin and Clinton Erin Daigle, were detained inside the location pending the investigation. It was later suspected that Baldwin and Daigle had left the residence at an unknown time during the night, leaving their 5 year and 3 year old children alone in the residence without adult supervision.

Sarah Isabelle Baldwin and Clinton Erin Daigle were arrested and booked into jail for felony hit and run and felony child endangerment. Both children were taken into protective custody by Child Protective Services.
