Sixth St. and Palm, Beaumont

**Incident:** Residential Burglary, Property Recovered, Suspects arrested

On Sunday, 07/06/2008, about 0900 hours, Patrol Officer F. Steward and Officer C. Walsh of the Beaumont Police Department stopped a gray Hyundai in the area of Sixth St and Palm, in the City of Beaumont, for traffic violations. The 16-year-old female driver, a resident of Banning, was driving the car without a driver's license in possession. The minor was accompanied by two male adult passengers.

Officer Steward conducted a search of the vehicle and found a loaded revolver. A check of the serial number revealed it was reported stolen in a residential burglary in the City of Banning on 07/05/2008. Also recovered was a pair of binoculars stolen in the same burglary.

The minor, passengers Deshawn Luther Needom, (DOB: 04/25/1989), and Quanale Smith (DOB:12/28/2008), both from Compton, California, were arrested for possession of a stolen property, possession of a loaded firearm in a vehicle and being minors in possession of a loaded firearm. Suspect Quanale Smith was on active parole from the California Youth Authority for Assault with a Deadly Weapon. The minor was detained at Riverside Juvenile Hall and suspects Needom and Smith were booked at the Smith Correctional Facility in Banning.

Banning Patrol Officer Jones and Sergeant A. Ortiz conducted a follow-up investigation at the burglary victim's house in the 1100 block of West Gilman St., City of Banning, and verified the recovered-stolen property with Victim D. Draper. The investigation is ongoing.
