Incident: Domestic Violence/ Officer Involved Shooting

On Sunday, July 14, 2013, about 2:25 a.m., Banning Police officers responded to a report of a male subject beating a female victim in the 1200 block of N. Hargrave Street, Banning. When police arrived, they found a 29 year old female victim of domestic violence. Officers attempted to detain the male suspect, identified as 31 year old Johnny Ray Vaughan of Banning. While attempting to handcuff Vaughan, he (Vaughan) broke free and a foot pursuit ensued. While chasing the suspect through a nearby alley, an officer involved shooting took place. Vaughan was not hit. The suspect was apprehended shortly thereafter without further incident.

No officers were injured during the incident and the suspect received minor injuries from a fall during the foot pursuit. The female victim was treated by paramedics for injuries she received during the domestic violence attack.

Vaughan is going to be booked at the Larry D. Smith Correctional Facility in Banning on felony charges of domestic violence, resisting arrest, and a parole violation.

The Riverside County District Attorney's Office responded to assist with the criminal investigation and the Riverside County Sheriff's Department's Forensic Unit responded to handle evidence collection and process the shooting scene. The circumstances surrounding this incident are still under investigation.
