Incident: Search Warrant Service (Fraud case #10-1816)

On July 15th, 2010, members of the Banning Police Department's Detective Bureau, officers from the Banning Police Department, investigators from the Riverside County Sheriff's Department, and members of the Sexual Assault Felony Enforcement (Safe) team, simultaneously served search warrants at three locations (950 W. Hoffer Street, 1224 W. Hoffer Street and 38632 Vineland Street).

The search warrants were served in order to obtain evidence related to an ongoing fraud case being investigated by the Banning Police Department. The victim in this case reported numerous fraudulent activities on her personal credit after a burglary to her residence. When officers served the search warrants, they located items associated with fraudulent purchases made under the victim's name, fictitious paperwork under the victim's name, personal information of other possible victims, two loaded .38 caliber revolvers, and methamphetamine.

James Rients Reitsma, the main suspect in this case, was arrested at the Cherry Valley residence and later booked for unauthorized use of a person's personal information, receiving stolen property, violation of probation, and failing to register as a sex offender.

Jayson Martin Williams and Mark Anthony Donaho were arrested at 1224 W. Hoffer Street. Information they provided indicated they were involved in a large scale fraud ring with Reitsma. Williams was booked for unauthorized use of a person's personal information, possession of stolen property, possession of a controlled substance, possession of a dangerous weapon and conspiracy to commit

a crime. Donaho was booked for possession of stolen property and violating the terms of his parole.
