On 8-16-09 about 1:57 P.M., officers of the Banning Police Department responded to the area of 600 North Hargrave Street for a report of a roll-over traffic collision with a male subject trapped inside. Due to the collision damage and vehicle's position, officers were unable to gain access to the driver trapped inside. Cal Fire, using the "Jaws of Life," gained access to the victim, but he had succumbed to his injuries. Riverside County Coroners were contacted and responded to the scene.

The victim was the only occupant and had been traveling north on Hargrave Street driving a gold Toyota Sienna. As he entered the intersection at George Street, he was struck on the passenger side by a gray Chrysler Cirrus traveling west on George Street. The collision caused the victim's vehicle to spin out of control and roll-over. The vehicle came to rest on its roof with the passenger side against a block wall.

The driver of the Chrysler was transported to the San Geronio Memorial Hospital in Banning with unknown injuries. The female driver was the only occupant.

The facts surrounding the traffic collision, including the identifications of the drivers involved, are being investigated.
