On Saturday, August 25, 2018, at about 1620 hours, detectives from the Banning Police Department responded to 1420 East Williams Street in the City of Banning to serve a Felony arrest warrant on Jacob Estrada, a 25 year old resident of the City of Banning. Estrada had three active felony warrants for his arrest. Once detectives arrived at the location, Estrada was immediately spotted inside a vehicle. When detectives attempted to take Estrada into custody, he fled in his vehicle and attempted to run over one of the detectives and crashed his vehicle into an unmarked police vehicle. After the crash, Estrada continued driving the vehicle for several hundred yards, where his vehicle became disabled. Estrada exited his vehicle and fled on foot to an address in the 300 block of Evans Street.

Estrada then barricaded himself inside the residence and refused to surrender to detectives. Banning Police Department requested the assistance of the Riverside County Sheriff's Department Special Enforcement Bureau, who ultimately took over the incident. After approximately a four hour standoff, Estrada surrendered to authorities. There were no injuries to Estrada, officers, or the public in this incident. Estrada was subsequently booked into the Larry D. Smith Correctional Facility for his three outstanding felony warrants, Assault with a Deadly Weapon on a Police Officer, and Hit and Run.
