Incident: Burglary Ring

On September 5, 2008, Banning Police Detectives and Patrol Officers conducted a search warrant at the residence of burglary ring leader, Ronald Dyshawn Willis Jr, located in the 400 Block of W. Ramsey Street, in the City of Banning. Detectives recovered stolen property, stolen cellular telephones and video game equipment from the two residential burglaries and one commercial burglary that occurred in the City of Banning.

Willis was responsible for pawning and selling the stolen items he received from the four juveniles whom were responsible for committing the three burglaries. The juveniles and Willis had mutually agreed to split the proceeds from the sale of the property stolen in the burglaries. The juvenile burglary ring was also found to be responsible for a burglary committed in the City of Beaumont where additional stolen property was recovered.

The juveniles were all arrested on September 3, 2008, by Banning Detectives and booked into the Riverside County Juvenile Hall, in the City of Riverside.

This total amount of property has yet to be determined; this investigation is still on-going.
