**Incident:** Wanted Parolee at Large Arrest

On 10-6-09, about 1120 hours, Banning Police Officers were dispatched to a report of a wanted “Armed and Dangerous Parolee at Large” suspect in the 1200 block area of Foothill Drive in Banning. As Officers arrived on scene, the suspect fled the area on foot. After Officers lost visual contact with the suspect, an extensive search was conducted in the surrounding area. The search included assistance from the California Highway Patrol Air and K-9 units and Beaumont Police Department. Officers were unable to locate the suspect.

About 1430 hours, Officers received a 911 call regarding a suspicious subject in the backyard of a residence in the 4400 block of West Hoffer Street in Banning. The description provided to the officers matched the Parolee at Large suspect from the previous call and the location was approximately two blocks away from the original call. As Officers arrived on scene, the suspect again fled on foot from officers. Officers were able to contain the suspect in the 1100 block area of Dysart Street where he was taken into custody. The suspect was transported by ambulance to Riverside County Regional Medical Center where he was treated for injuries he sustained during the arrest. The suspect was booked into the security ward at the medical center for the Parolee at Large warrant, felony resisting arrest, and being under the influence of a controlled substance.

The suspect was identified as Joseph Rangel, 27 years old, from Mentone.
