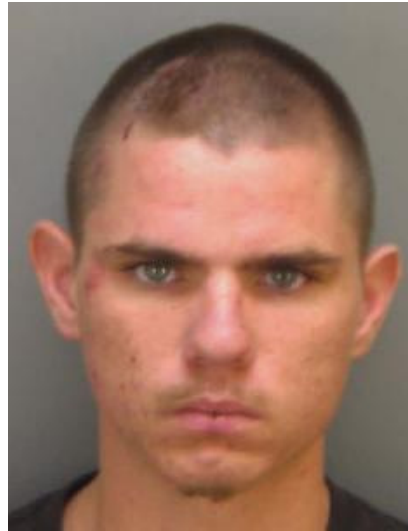

Incident: Grand Theft

On Sunday, October 19, 2008, at approximately 9:40 p.m., Banning Police Officers responded to an in progress theft at Clark's Towing, located in the 200 block of E. Lincoln Street.

Upon arrival, Officers learned the owner of the business was monitoring security video cameras of the business when he observed two male subjects enter the fenced in storage yard. The business owner continued to watch the suspects while calling the Banning Police Department. Banning Police Officers, with the assistance of Beaumont Police Officers successfully, set up a perimeter and captured both suspects. An estimated \$450 worth of stolen property was recovered along with stolen property from a previous burglary at the same location. Both suspects were arrested and charged with theft, possession of stolen property, and conspiracy to commit theft. Auston Livingston was booked into the Banning Correctional Facility, while the Juvenile was booked into Riverside Juvenile Hall.
