Incident: Pursuit of Armed Suspect

On October 29, 2013 at approximately 1200 hours, Officers from the Banning Police Department were dispatched to the 2700 block of W. Ramsey Street regarding a report of domestic violence in progress. The original caller was later identified as the mother-in-law of the suspect and said she was being held at gun point by her estranged son-in-law. The son-in-law was later identified as Jaime Quevedo, age 34, of Banning. Officers responded and located the mother at a convenience store. The woman reported that she escaped from Quevedo after trying to prevent him from assaulting her daughter. Quevedo reportedly chased his mother-in-law to the store in his vehicle. While she was on the phone with police, she reported he was fleeing the area in his vehicle. Officers located Quevedo driving his vehicle and a short pursuit ensued through the City of Banning. Quevedo was pursued back to his residence where he jumped out of the truck and fled into his residence. Quevedo surrendered to officers without incident after exiting his house without a firearm. Officers detained Quevedo and obtained a search warrant for his home where they located the firearm described by the victim. Ammunition belonging to the firearm was located in Quevedo's vehicle. Quevedo was arrested for assault with a deadly weapon and evading police and booked into Smith Correctional Facility. The mother-in-law was treated at the scene by CALFIRE for minor injuries she sustained during the attack and returned home.
